The purpose of this project is to grow our educational experience and to improve our language skills, while having fun meeting and getting to know the Italian students from Marie Curie-Carlo Levi school, from Collegno and Torino.

Our trip had started in our city, Targu Mures Romania at 1:00AM, when we met to get by our parents' cars to Cluj-Napoca to get to the airport.
